23-1-110. Confidentiality of game and fish records.

3 (a) Proprietary records, data and information obtained 4 by the department as a result of a study or research on 5 wildlife issues shall be deemed confidential and are not 6 public records for purposes of W.S. 16-4-201 through 16-4-7 205 if the records, data or information have not been 8 publicly released. The director may direct or permit 9 disclosure of any records, data and information specified

in this subsection as the director deems necessary.

12 (b) Unless otherwise provided by law, the director may
13 deny the right of inspection for purposes of W.S. 16-4-201
14 through 16-4-205 of any records, data or information
15 collected or obtained by the department that concerns
16 sensitive geospatial information if the director determines
17 releasing the records, data or information would be
18 contrary to the public interest or detrimental to wildlife.

20 (c) Any person denied the right to inspect any 21 record, data or information covered by this section may 22 apply to the district court of the district wherein the 23 record, data or information is found for an order directing

1	the director to show cause why he should not permit the
2	inspection of the record, data or information.

4	(d) For purposes of this section, "sensitive
5	geospatial information" includes:

7	(i) Radio frequencies used in, or locational data
8	generated by, wildlife studies;

LO	(ii) Location data collected by the department or
L1	generated by global positioning system devices or other
L2	devices designed to provide specific locations of wildlife;

L 4	(iii) Other wildlife information that may lead to
L 5	the determination of a specific location, migration route,
L 6	den site, rendezvous site or nest site of an individual
L 7	animal or group of animals.
