The Committee will receive proposed revisions or updates to military-related statues. The second day of the meeting the Committee will receive testimony regarding vehicle registration, fines and depreciation, regarding WyoLink operations and improvements, regarding Revenue Information System modernization and regarding the I-80 master plan. The Committee will also receive reports regarding specialty license plates, designation between transplant and scientific organ donation options, Public Safety Communications Commission updates and any government or industry developments affecting transportation or highways. Following each topic, the Committee will accept public comment.
