

**KEY DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATES
AND REPEALS**

The following is a list of laws which will become effective or be repealed at some future date, unless the Legislature acts to amend the law. The Legislature often "sunset" certain provisions when a bill is enacted, or delays a law's effective date until a specified time in the future. Many of these provisions are intended to simply sunset or become effective as provided, however, some provisions contain delayed dates because, as evidenced by debates, the Legislature "intends" to review the status of the law in the future. This list is provided so members of the Legislature (including Committees) can request legislation as they deem appropriate to amend delayed effective and repeal dates. This year LSO has augmented this listing by including reversion dates for appropriations that are not standard "at the end of the fiscal biennium" reversions.
