THE FEDERAL LAND POLICY AND MANAGEMENT ACT (FLPMA) OF 1976

- Management on the basis of multiple use and sustained yield [Section 102(a)(7)]
- Protect the environment [Section 102(a)(8)]
- Develop land use plans with public involvement [Section 202(a)]

Establish goals and objectives as guidelines for public land use planning.

TYPES OF LAND USE PLAN DECISIONS


- × Desired Outcomes
 - + Goals and Objectives

- × Allowable Uses
 - + Allocations of allowable, restricted, or prohibited uses on the public land and mineral estate
 - + Management Actions anticipated to achieve the desired outcomes (includes proactive and restrictive measures)


