Calling on Congress to initiate the process to amend the United States Constitution to state in the Tenth Amendment that all powers not <u>expressly</u> delegated to the federal government are reserved to the states or to the people, and stating that the Tenth Amendment "shall be considered by all courts as a rule of interpretation and construction in any case involving an interpretation of any constitutional power claimed by the Congress.".....
